We're so pleased you decided to get a Mastercard Multi-currency Cash Passport, the smart, reliable and convenient way to manage your travel money. Your Card is chip and PIN protected, not linked to your bank account and safer than cash. Your money will be available at millions of ATMs worldwide, displaying the Mastercard Acceptance Mark. Alternatively, you can use your Card to pay in store or online, as long as the merchant accepts Mastercard prepaid cards.

## Let's stick together

In addition to packing the essentials for your trip, we recommend you take this Procedures Guide along with you. If you need our help, it will come in handy.

### Let's get you started

We know you're busy planning your trip and with **3 EASY STEPS** your Card can be ready to be used.

STEP 1	Sign and print your name on the back of your Card.		
STEP 2	Remember your PIN. Your Card is now active and ready to be used.		
STEP 3	Create your online account by logging in to 'My Account' at www.intercamcashpassport.com.mx to view your Card balance, move money between Currencies and check your transactions.		

That's it. You're ready to travel and spend!

## Things you can do with your Card

**Buy things for** yourself, friends or family - in shops and online

Things you shouldn't do with your Card

When you're on your travels, you may get the choice of paying in Mexican Pesos rather than the local currency. By choosing to pay in the local currency, you may avoid an extra foreign exchange conversion at additional cost to you. Remember that if the local currency is not one of the Currencies on your Card, or you do not have enough funds in

this Currency, the rest will be taken from another Currency on your Card in the following order: US Dollars, Canadian Dollars, Pounds Sterling, Euros and Japanese Yen. For applicable fees, please refer to www.intercamcashpassport.com.mx to find out more.

Whilst your Card is really adaptable, it's not suitable for everything. You shouldn't use your Card as a deposit with car rental companies, hotels or cruise lines. This is because they will estimate the final bill and will require a sum of money to be reserved on your Card to cover this. You will not be able to spend the reserved amount for some time.

# Your Card is smart

Your Card can carry up to 5 Currencies every time you travel and initially uses the local Currency of the country you visit. Load it with US Dollars, Canadian Dollars, Pounds Sterling, Euros and/or Japanese Yen and keep it loaded with the relevant Currency (or Currencies). If you don't have enough of the local Currency on your Card, it can check the other Currencies on your Card, in the order described above, to see if it can cover the bill. # Here for the long haul

Your Card isn't just for one trip; you can use it again and again (up to the expiry date shown on the Card) and simply reload it when you next go traveling\*. If there has been no activity on your Card (such as buying something, making an ATM withdrawal or reloading) for anonths or longer, then you may incur an inactivity fee. This is shown in the Fees and Limits table.

#### Keeping you on track

Before using your Card, here are the things you should check.

- Is there enough money on the Card for the purchase or withdrawal you wish to make?
- Does the merchant or ATM accept Mastercard prepaid cards?

Are you using the correct PIN? The 'How to..?' section of this Procedures Guide advises you how to get a reminder.

Is the transaction within the maximum Card limits? For example, the maximum daily amount that you can spend in a shop. These limits are shown in the Fees and Limits table. In addition, some ATMs may have their own limits.

# Did you forget your PIN?

If you forget your PIN, you can get a PIN reminder by phoning the Card Services Center on the telephone numbers in the 'Phone' section in this Procedures Guide. Please note, it is not possible to change your PIN.

# What do I do if my Card has been lost/stolen or damaged?

Call the Card Services Center immediately, we have a team of friendly and expert staff ready to help you. We won't leave you stranded and, subject to availability, can offer emergency cash (up to the available Card balance) and/or a Replacement Card.

#### Can I use my Card anywhere in the world and in any currency?

Your Card will work nearly everywhere in the world where the Mastercard Acceptance Mark is displayed. Please visit the ATM locator section at www.intercamcashpassport.com.mx for a list of countries and geographical regions where you cannot use your Card. You can use your Card to pay in any currency. For applicable fees, please refer to www.intercamcashpassport.com.mx to find out more.

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If the currency of your transaction matches one of the Currencies on the Card and there are sufficient funds in that Currency to cover the whole transaction, the ATM fee for that Currency will be applied. If the currency of your transaction does not match one of the Currencies on the Card or there are insufficient funds in the relevant Currency to cover the whole transaction, then the USS ATM fee will be applied and will be converted into least Currency being used to fund the transaction at a foreign exchange rate determined by Mastercard on the day the transaction is processed.
